This morning, we take a short and scenic trip to southern Hawke’s Bay where we are hosted by a creative group of fibre artists. These passionate artists are dedicated to teaching and developing a wide range of arts and handicrafts to people in their rural district. You will be inspired as you watch them at work on their diverse projects, from intricate embroidery and wool crafts to stunning mosaics, papercraft, and beautiful patchwork quilting. Enjoy morning tea, browse their displays, and check out their sales table. Following this creative fix, we head north to visit an historic

homestead for a tour, followed by lunch and a walk around the beautiful gardens, which will be flourishing with spring growth. Owned by six generations of the same family, there is a lot of passion evident in this elegant homestead and gardens.

Return to Napier. Our hotel is located on the waterfront and a 3-minute walk to the city centre. Take some time at leisure – perhaps take a stroll along the Marine Parade 3km stretch of seaside walkway with views of Mahia Peninsular in the North to Cape Kidnappers in the South. See the sunken gardens, reef gardens, Ocean viewing platform and the famous Pania of the Reef statue. Hawke’s Bay has an array of wonderful creativity and textile shops to explore.

This morning, visit a shop with decades of spinning experience. Here you can purchase all types of premium natural fibre yarn direct from the mill. We have a presentation to learn about their Penguin rescue program of knitting Penguin Jerseys, and shopping opportunity time. Be sure to bring your patterns!

Next, we travel a short distance to a very special place in the heart of Hawkes Bay for a lunch at leisure, with time to visit the magnificent gallery featuring both New Zealand and African art. Enjoy a walk through the extensive gardens with its many sculptures by both international and New Zealand



artists. Continue to a very interesting Patchwork & Quilting shop, which is a beloved haven for all quilting enthusiasts! Enjoy a presentation and explore their extensive collection of quilting supplies with time for shopping. Return to hotel, with dinner at leisure. There are many local restaurants close to our hotel.

Start the day with a fun visit to a quirky shop brimming with antique, Art Deco, and retro treasures! From vintage clothing and jewellery to unique accessories and embroideries, you'll be taken back to an era where every item was a masterpiece crafted to last.

Visit the Napier Art Deco Centre and learn about

the rebuild of the city – Art Deco style. With 140 buildings constructed between 1920 and 1940, Napier stands as one of the world's premiere Art Deco cities, and a living museum of style and history.

Next, we are everything about needlework as we visit the home studio of a passionate embroiderer and needlework designer. Enjoy morning tea, as you view her exquisite collection of fine needlework designs and antique reproductions. Take the opportunity to shop for unique supplies and accessories for your own creations.

We visit the MTG Hawkes Bay Museum. There is something for everyone at this museum in the heart of the Hawkes Bay art and culture center, with many exhibitions to explore, including the incredible Napier Earthquake Exhibition.

This evening, we have a farewell dinner in a quaint local restaurant, where we'll savour culinary flavours of the region. This is the perfect opportunity to reminisce about our week together, share stories and laughter, and celebrate our newfound friendships.

## Price & Fluctuation

All prices quoted are in New Zealand dollars and subject to change without notice having regard to unforeseen circumstances, foreign exchange fluctuations, and variations in coach operating costs including but not limited to fuel and tariffs.

In the event of currency exchange deviation from the costed tour, Farm & Leisure Tours Ltd reserves the right to increase prices or make refunds according to the impact the fluctuation has had on land content prices in the country or countries being visited. NB: If minimum numbers are not reached with full paying Farm & Leisure Tours Ltd passengers – any possible refund or favourable exchange fluctuations may be foregone to ensure the tour still proceeds as planned. If for any reason an airline or service provider is unable to provide a service, we will endeavour to arrange an alternative supplier. If this is not possible, we will return to you any funds owed to that airline or supplier and still held by Farm & Leisure Tours Ltd.

## Minimum Numbers & Additional Travel

The tour will proceed with a minimum number (as indicated) of full paying passengers. If the minimum number is not reached, the tour may still proceed however, per passenger prices may change.
